Vision	<p>The vision of Canyon Rim Prepares is to increase the readiness, resiliency, and ability of the CRCA community to support immediate needs in the face of disasters or catastrophic events. This will be accomplished through active engagement of the community in planning, organizing, equipping, and training for high consequence events, including earthquakes, infectious disease outbreaks, or intentional acts impacting our community. Canyon Rim Prepares will be developed in collaboration with other similar programs, including CERT, SAFE Neighborhoods, Millcreek Emergency Management, and others.</p>
Mission	<p>The vision will be achieved through a structured process of supply acquisition, key leadership and community orientation, ongoing training, and maintenance of caches. This project will be targeted to improve CRCA community readiness through access to knowledge, skills, and abilities, and access to commonly needed supplies in support of sheltering, basic first aid, and structure access and extrication.</p>
Promotion	<p>Canyon Rim Prepares will ensure community awareness of training opportunities and cache contents and uses through existing messaging platforms (Millcreek newsletter, CRCA website, Nextdoor), through direct outreach to CRCA community (mailers, emails), and other methods as needed.</p>
Objectives	<p>Planning – Cache activation and use plan will be developed and shared with community members and key leadership. This plan will be coordinated with Millcreek City Emergency Operations Plan.</p> <p>Organizing – Cache key access will be determined and keys distributed to identified points of contact. Points of contact will accept responsibility for opening cache if needed. Points of contact list will be shared and updated as needed.</p> <p>Equipping – Cache contents will be vetted with CRCA subject matter experts. Cache purchases will be prioritized as follows: on-site sheltering supplies, first aid and medical care equipment, tools and hard goods for go-bags.</p> <p>Training – On site training will be conducted biannually for key leadership and interested community members. Standard operating procedures and written training materials will be available for distribution to community. Training will be coordinated with Millcreek CERT and SAFE Neighborhoods.</p>
Action Plan	<p>Aug-Sept 2019 – Complete purchases for cache. Develop draft SOP. Distribute keys to POC. Install storage and desk supplies in cache as completed by Eagle Scouts.</p> <p>Oct-Nov 2019 – Complete SOP, coordinate with Millcreek EM for plan alignment. Engage other Millcreek Community Councils and provide guidance to move forward on their plans.</p> <p>Spring 2020 – Project will be promoted through CRCA community area.</p> <p>Summer 2020 – Initiate a new cache project for CRCA areas that cannot be served by the existing cache locations. (Utah School for Deaf and Blind?)</p> <p>Unknown – Move cache from temporary location at Rosecrest Ward to final location at Rosecrest Elementary. Engage community group for site prep.</p>
